

## F.A.Q.'s

### What is Paintball?

Paintball is a game / sport played by millions of people worldwide. It is the fastest growing extreme sport in the world and is one of the most popular "team building" exercises. The game itself is a combination of hide and seek, brandy, chess etc. It is a team sport that is very fast, very exciting and will get your adrenalin pumping. There are many different types of games and objectives. The most common game is to get the flag from the center of the field and take it to the opposite end without getting tagged by a paintball. If a player is tagged, that player is eliminated from the game. Several games are played throughout the day.

### Does it hurt?

We often hear players say "It doesn't hurt as much as I thought". We use paintballs that are quite brittle, therefore they break easier on impact. Our paintballs are also stored in a temperature controlled environment to keep them in top condition. We provide overalls, masks and vests to help protect players. If paintballs really hurt a lot, people would just stop playing! Yes, some may sting for a few seconds, but it's those flying little balls that gives you the adrenalin buzz of playing Paintball! Hearing those paintballs zipping past and hitting your barricade as you're shooting back and trying to out smart your opposition..... There's nothing like it!

### What is the minimum Age?

Players **MUST** be 10 years of age or above as per South Australian Firearms Law.

### What is the minimum or maximum group size?

We cater for small & large groups. We also cater for individuals!

Small groups & individuals can be merged together to make larger groups.

Experience shows that groups of 15+ players will have more action packed games and adrenalin pumping fun than smaller groups. If you get 20 players, not only will you have more fun, but you (the organiser) will also play for FREE and get 400 paintballs FREE!

### What do you wear?

On warm or hot days you will probably want to wear shorts and a T-shirt under your overalls. Baseball style caps are recommended. Good condition closed in shoes / joggers with good grip is essential. **(No thongs or sandals permitted)**

### Can you drink alcohol?

**NO!** Paintball markers are registered firearms. Paintball Park is a registered "shooting range". Anyone under the influence of alcohol or drugs will be refused entry and be required to leave.

### Can you bring your own equipment?

You can bring your own marker (*Paintball gun*). It **must** be registered. Registration papers and your current firearms licence **must** be provided on the day. (*Please bring a photo copy of both for our records*).

Players bringing markers (*Paintball guns*) **must** report immediately to reception. Your marker **must** be in a box or bag and **must not** be removed or visible. It **must** be disassembled/de-gassed and **must not** be assembled in the "meeting" area.

Your own masks, harnesses, clothing etc can be used. (*Visit our photo gallery & pre purchase your own personal Paintball equipment before your day of play*). Masks **must** be inspected by the Paintball Park "Range Master" before use.

### Can you bring your own paintballs?

**NO!** Only Paintballs supplied by Paintball Park are to be used.
